New Irrigation Contracts Mailed

Irrigation customers should have received new irrigation

contracts via mail in January. Along with these contracts were a list of the customer's irrigation service(s) with North Central Public Power District. The list showed the current load control schedule each service is currently signed up for, plus additional information to help identify each service(s). This list of information can be used to assist customers when selecting the load control schedule on the new irrigation contract for the 2019 irrigation season. The load control schedules that are available are: 6 Day Control, 3 Day Control, 2 Day Control and No Control. The rates associated with the load control schedules are shown in the table. All schedules except No Control are subject to Sunday control as required based on the level of North Central's demand. The irrigation contracts should be completed, signed and returned to our office by February 20, 2019 for billing purposes.

Irrigation Facility Charge to be billed in February

The 2019 Irrigation Facility Charge for irrigation services that are 15 horsepower or larger will be billed in February. If you are considering changing the load control schedule (i.e from 3 Day Control to 2 Day Control) on any irrigation service(s) or if any irrigation services need to be transferred into your name or into someone else's name, please notify our office of any changes. New irrigation contracts will need to be completed and returned to our office before any changes on the billing system will be made. The deadline to make any load control changes is March 29, 2019.

Doritos™ Cheesy Chicken Casserole

Ingredients

- 1 bag (10 oz) Doritos™ Cool Ranch™ flavored tortilla chips, coarsely crushed (about 6 cups)
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- 2 cups shredded Colby-Monterey Jack cheese (8 oz)
- 1 jar (15 oz) four cheese Alfredo pasta sauce
- 1 tablespoon taco seasoning mix (from 1-oz package)
- 3 cups shredded cooked chicken
- 1 can (14.5 oz) fire roasted diced tomatoes, undrained

Directions

Heat oven to 350°F. Spray 13x9-inch baking dish with cooking spray. In large bowl, toss Doritos™ and melted butter until well coated. Sprinkle 4 cups of the Doritos™ evenly in bottom of casserole. Top with ½ cup of the cheese. In large bowl, stir pasta sauce and taco seasoning mix until well blended. Add chicken, tomatoes and ½ cup of the cheese; stir until well mixed. Spoon evenly over Doritos™ in baking dish. Bake uncovered 30 minutes. Sprinkle with remaining Doritos™ and remaining 1 cup cheese. Bake about 5 minutes longer or until hot and cheese is melted.

Office Must be Notified of Irrigation Changes

Irrigation customers are reminded if you have made any changes or are planning on making some changes on your irrigation service(s) such as replacing an old irrigation system with a new system, or replacing an old pump panel with a new one, you need to notify North Central PPD's office. The customer is responsible for making arrangements to have the equipment removed and returned to our office. If the load control equipment is missing when the annual irrigation inspection is done in the spring, the customer will be notified and will be responsible for locating the equipment and returning it to North Central or will be billed for the cost of the missing equipment.
